Theory / Method / Workflow

Methane emission reductions from the Well Done Projects are measurably quantifiable, immediate and permanent. We use state of the industry techniques for our monitoring and measurement processes and are quite literally “writing the book”.

Results, Observations, Conclusions

To date, the Well Done Foundation has adopted 14 orphan oil and gas wells in Northern Montana, has plugged five (5) and is on track to plug 25 more in 2021. Additionally, the Well Done Foundation is starting up operations in Pennsylvania, New York, West Virginia, Ohio, Louisiana, Texas and Kansas this Spring.

Novel/Additive Information

This platform could be a game changer for the way that the Oil & Gas Industry can own being a part of a legacy problem and set an example for other industries to follow along and be a part of making things better.
